THE GREAT AMERICAN SMOKEOUT CELEBRATES ITS 26TH YEAR

The Great American SmokeOut, observed this year on Thursday, November 21, challenges people of all ages to stop using tobacco and raises awareness of effective ways to quit. You can include information on the health effects of smoking in your lessons or programs with the following video.

Women and Tobacco: Seven Deadly Myths

Produced by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in 2001, this video presents the serious health effects of smoking on women and discusses myths that surround women and smoking. The benefits of quitting are also described. Although suitable for grades 9 through adults, some segments, such as the lung of a smoker, are graphic.

DECEMBER 1 IS WORLD AIDS DAY

Observed every year on December 1, the theme for World Aids Day 2002 is "Stigma and Discrimination." Accurate information can help confront the fears and biases that lead to stigma and discrimination.

HIV AND AIDS: Staying Safe

Intended for students in grades 4 - 6, this video explains how HIV affects the immune system. Ways that people can NOT contract HIV are emphasized as well as ways that they can. Children are helped to realize that they are ultimately responsible for their own health. The video was produced by United Learning in 2001.

In Our Own Words: Teens and AIDS

Five young people who contracted HIV as teenagers through unprotected sexual intercourse are profiled in this 20-minute video. An introduction to HIV and AIDS is recommended prior to viewing the video. Produced in 1995, the impact on the young people conveys a powerful message. Suitable for students in grades 7 - 12.
