General Counsel Fader asked to comment on the resolutions that just passed. He stated that the Assessment and Transition Agreement and Exhibits with BRMC LP is necessary for the smooth transition at the conclusion of the existing lease (LOA), especially with no disruption to patient care. The transition period would be a 6 month period which commences at the end of the existing LOA whereby ToneyKorf Partnership on behalf of the BCIA will be able to assess and evaluate the hospital operations, develop and implement protocols and procedure to have a seamless transition for all employees to the next long term operator, review and evaluate existing contracts, review and assess clinical and other health care services. As part of the Transition Agreement an amendment was made to the Promissory Note executed in 1998 at the commencement of the original LOA

which set forth repayment in three years after the end of the original lease period, which would be 2020. Today's amendment will guarantee that the County/BCIA would recover a minimum \$22.5 million this year. These monies could be used to assure a smooth transition to new long term operator. This agreement also permits ToneyKorf to maintain offices at the BRMC site, handle items on our behalf, and allows us sufficient time to engage a long term operator. Counsel Fader thanked the County/BCIA staff as well as the professionals for their hard work in this endeavor.
