

June 2, 2021

A regular meeting of the Bergen County Board of Taxation was held on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at TWO Bergen County Plaza, Tax Board Hearing Room A, Hackensack, NJ. The meeting was called to order by President Calabrese at 9:30 A.M. and compliance with the Sunshine Law was indicated. The roll call was taken:

1. Revaluations/Reassessments

2022 – Reassessments for all 2022 towns approved by the Director of the Division of Taxation. Assessors are expected to send in status reports.

Wallington is a revaluation.

2. SR1A Report – The Board is approximately 1 month behind in processing SR1A's. Assessors were asked to please complete them and get them in to the Board.

3. Resolution 21-03 – All 70 districts have been listed for assessment corrections. A motion was made by Commissioner Schettino and seconded by Commissioner Eilert to approve Resolution 21-03.

None


The meeting was opened to the public at 9:40 AM.
