- As we inch back to a normal world, our residents experience activities in the chapel, maintaining a group of fewer than ten plus social distancing. Additionally, residents have resumed using the therapy gym for therapy. All areas are disinfected after use.
- Testing of staff continues twice a week during the county high COVID-19 activity level. Results continue to be negative.
- Additional staff have recently received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccination.
- Appropriate PPE equipment is provided to our staff to keep them and residents safe.
- New signs have been installed at our entrances informing visitors about limits on visiting.
