## **CONNECTIONS: HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY PREPARATION/LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION**

### **OVERVIEW**

- Connections is a program for out-ofschool youth sponsored by the Bergen County Division of Family Guidance. It is located on the campus of Bergen Community College at the Meadowlands in Lyndhurst, NJ.
- Connections helps students obtain their high school equivalency diploma, secure admission to college or other training programs and/or prepare for employment.
- The program emphasizes basic skills, habits and attitudes that are appropriate for the world of work
- There is no charge to participate in Connections.
- The staff an academic teacher, vocational counselor and program administrator address individual needs by providing a structured program with individualized support and guidance.
- Family Guidance resources such as individual and family counseling and learning assessments are available to
   <u>Connections</u> students on an as needed basis

### **GETTING STARTED**

### Who is eligible?

Bergen County residents 16 through 21 years old who are no longer enrolled in high school. We encourage students to sign out of school only after they have been accepted at **Connections.** 

## How do I apply?

Contact staff at (201) 937-7236 to schedule an appointment for a personal interview. Placement testing is given to determine your strengths in each of the tests on the High School Equivalency Examination: Mathematics, Reading, Writing, Science and Social Studies.

## How long is the Program?

It varies based on the individual's academic skill level. The average length of stay is four to six months.

## When are the classes?

In-person and virtual classes are available Monday through Friday throughout the year.
