MEDICARE PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFIT

WHAT IT DOES	ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS	HOW TO APPLY	COMMENTS
Medicare Part D is an optional program, which adds prescription drug coverage to original Medicare. There are monthly premiums, co-pay and may include annual deductible. Plans run on a calendar year and cover about 75% of drug costs until one reaches cap level. Any further drug costs for the remainder of the year will be out-of-pocket (about 25%) unless one reaches a catastrophic level then there will be a flat rate or 5% co-pay.	Must be enrolled in Medicare, either Part A or Part B. There is a penalty for late enrollment in Medicare Part D when first eligible. PAAD participants and dual eligible (Medicare/Medicaid) must enroll in a Medicare Part D "benchmark plan". Those who have been determined to have creditable coverage may not need to enroll. Benchmark plans for dual eligible and PAAD participants are premium free and are also waived late enrollment penalty. Rx plan's cap limit, deductibles, gap coverage do not apply. OTHER PROPERTY TAX BENEFITS

Senior Citizens or Disabled Persons Property Tax Deduction:

Annual deduction of up to \$250 from property tax for homeowners age 65 or older or disabled who meet residency requirements and surviving spouse may also qualify. Check with your municipality about necessary Forms.

Veterans Deduction:

Annual deduction of up to \$250 from property taxes due for qualified war veterans or for veterans who served in peacekeeping missions and operations. This deduction also applies to the unmarried surviving spouse/civil union/domestic partner. There is also full exemption from property taxes on a principal residence for total and permanently disabled war veterans and veterans who served in peacekeeping missions and operations. Check with your municipality about necessary Forms.
