VISUAL ART APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS 2020 Bergen County Teen Arts Festival

The final application form is due on **January 17, 2020.** Limit of 10 pieces per registration fee. This includes both 2-D and 3-D works.

General Directions

- 1. Art will be hung by school name, not genre. Your panel will be pre-assigned.
- 2. Each school will be allowed a hanging surface of 6' by 6' only. This will be two wire mesh panels. Work should be hung using S hooks or medium size clips.
- 3. Work which cannot fit onto the 6' by 6' space cannot be displayed. In order to provide for a safe, orderly exhibit, it will not be permitted to place work on the floor or in the area of your assigned panel. Each work must be hung safely on the provided 6' by 6' wire mesh panels.
- 4. The Master Sheet attached, <u>must be completely filled out and brought with you when you come to hang the art the day PRIOR to the festival.</u> Student personal information will not be required on this form only on the Release of Liability Form. If you have more than 10 entries, copy the Master Sheet. There is a fee of \$20 for each piece of art over the 10 piece limit. Space for the additional works will be assigned as available. Three Dimensional works are included in the total number, but they are placed on separate tables. Bring the completely filled out Master Sheet with you on **Thursday May 14, 2020** to present to the Art Advisory Committee.
- 5. Please duplicate the attached Visual Art Critique two sided, please. One for each piece of artwork you are exhibiting. Be sure to fill out the identifying information on the critique form completely. Teachers are responsible for attaching the critique form next to each artwork. No form no critique.
- 6. Also included are 10 labels for the displayed work. Please complete these, separate them and attach appropriately to or nearby each work.
- 7. Work that is not available for further display at the additional exhibition at the Bergen County Administration Building should be indicated appropriately on the label.
- 8. A Release of Liability Forms is included in this packet. Please duplicate and have each student complete, sign, obtain parents signature and submit with the Master Sheet on Thursday, May 14, 2020 prior to hanging of the work. All works on display must have a Release of Liability Form or they will not be permitted to be part of the show.
- 9. <u>All artwork must be hung/displayed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Thursday May 14, 2020. Critiquing begins promptly at 11:00 a.m.</u>

- 10. We are encouraging all schools to keep the art show intact until at least 1:00 PM on Friday, May 15. All art work should be available for all attendees to view throughout the Teen Arts Festival. Our goal is to have your students work get the recognition it deserves and have the show "complete" as long as possible. An art teacher or their representative must sign out with the Visual Arts Planning Committee <u>before</u> dismantling their display.
- 11. Be certain you bring enough appropriate materials (picture hooks and hanging wire are acceptable, string. Masking tape, duct tape and nails are not acceptable) to hang your students' work.
- 12. Frames with glass, and jewelry will NOT be permitted to be displayed.
- 13. Entries for the 2020 Teen Arts Festival Program Cover should be brought on May 14, 2020 and the appropriate application form (see below) should be completed.

Additional entries over those included in your school Registration Fee will be accepted as space permits. The fee for additional entries is \$20 per work.

Be sure to fill out this form completely and legibly. Return it to your school liaison. All final application forms must be in the Teen Arts office by **January 17, 2020.**

Your registration fee entitles you to display a combination of 10 pieces of 2-D and 3-D art. All 2-D pieces must fit onto a 4x8 foot panel. Sculpture (3-D work) will be placed on separate tables.

2020 Teen Arts Festival Program Cover Application

PLEASE BRING ENTRIES WITH YOU ON THURSDAY MAY 14, 2020 WHEN YOU COME TO HANG YOUR SCHOOLS ART DISPLAY.

The Teen Arts Festival Advisory Board and Art Planning Committee are requesting that any junior or senior high school participating in the Annual Teen Arts Festival, if they wish, submit entries to be considered for use as the cover for the following year's Bergen County Teen Arts Festival program. There will be a limit of 10 submissions per school.

The cover of the 2020 program will be chosen by the Art Planning Committee from the entries submitted. Other entries will be used, as space permits, within the program. There is no guarantee on how many submissions per school will be used as program art as has been the case for the past two years. All artists whose work is used will be recognized in the program.

The requirements which must be strictly followed are as follows:

- 1. All entries must be brought to the 2020 Teen Arts Festival on the Thursday prior to the festival (May 14, 2020) when you come to hang your art.
- 2. Entries must be on card stock type material and be approximately 8.5 inches high by 11 inches wide. Entries that do not conform to these measurements may be resized appropriately to fit the requirements of the cover and the program.
- 3. Entries must be black and white. For example, they can be pen & ink or black cut paper placed on white paper, or white cut paper on black paper.
- 4. Entries created digitally will be accepted but they must be black and white and suitable for offset printing appropriate to our "non-color" cover.
- 5. Entries should depict all the various artistic genres represented at the festival; art; creative writing; dance; film & video; instrumental music; vocal music, and theater.
- 6. The artists name, grade, address, home phone number and school must be printed on the back of the submitted piece of art.
- 7. Entries must be from students in grades 7 through 11 ONLY! No senior entries will be considered as they will have already graduated prior to the festival program being printed and issued at the festival.
