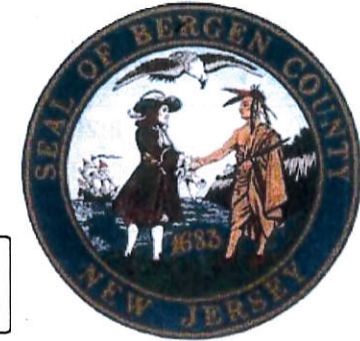

Non-Discrimination policy

A complaint must be filed within 180 days of the alleged discrimination. Bergen County management, and all supervisors and employees share direct responsibility for carrying out Bergen County's commitment to Title VI and ADA. Bergen County Community Transportation ensures accountability in this commitment, and supports all parts of the organization in meeting their respective Title VI and ADA obligations. Bergen County Transportation Department coordinates internally with all appropriate offices in the investigation of complaints of discrimination, and takes a lead role in responding to requests for information about Bergen County civil rights obligations and operations.

The Transit Connector service is partially funded through a grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) in conjunction with the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority.

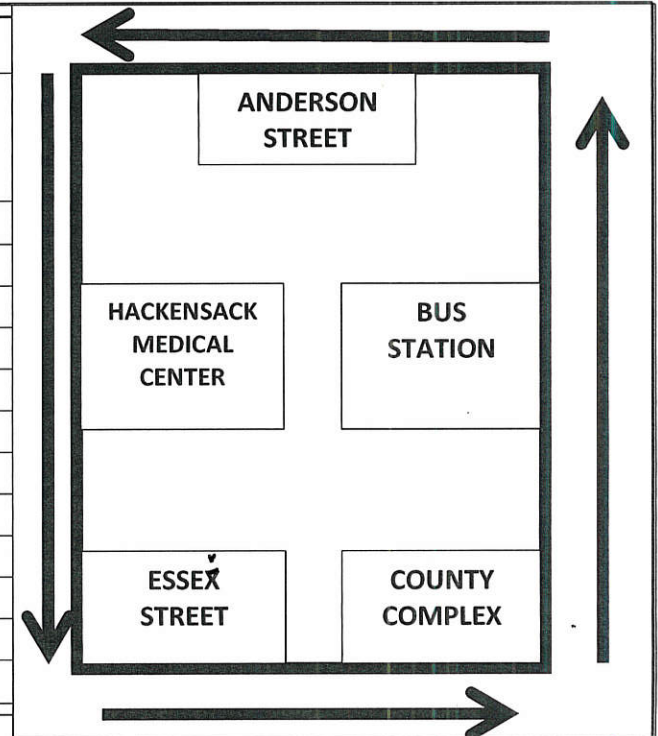

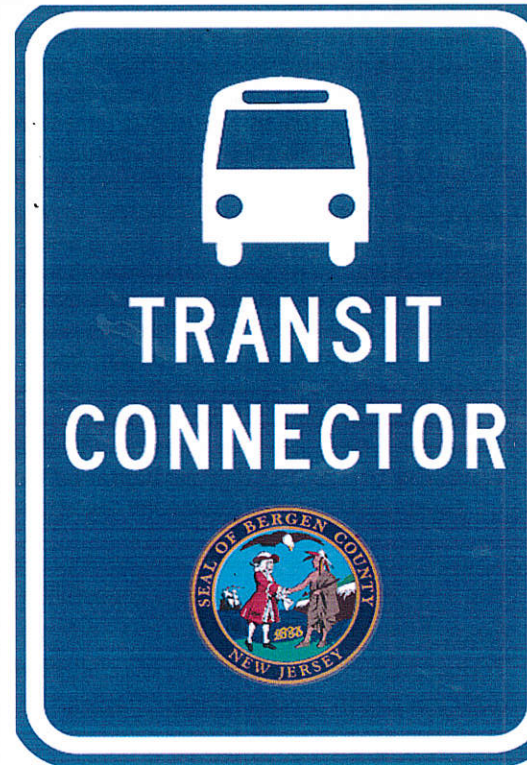
